ICWOD	Introduction to Cyber Warfare and Operations Design (2 days)
DCOE	Certified Defensive Cyber Operations Engineer (3 days)
CCA	Certified Collections Analyst (3 days)
CSCOE	Certified SCADA Cyber Operations Engineer (5 days)
RCCJOA	Radicalization and Counter/Cyber Jihadist Operations Analyst (1 day)

The first planned training dates in Gothenburg are:

Oct 8-12	ICWOD + DCOE (cyber warfare core training), 5 days incl. certification
Oct 13	RCCJOA, one day training incl. certification
Oct 15-19	ICWOD + DCOE (cyber warfare core training), 5 days incl. certification
Oct 20	RCCJOA, one day training and certification
Nov 12-16	ICWOD + DCOE (cyber warfare core training), 5 days incl. certification
Nov 17	RCCJOA, one day training and certification

A minimum of eight (8) students are required for each training opportunity. During open trainings participants may come from other countries. Depending on the number of participants that come from the Stockholm region, the training can be held there too.

Sectyne and CSFI screen all applications, where we, for instance, will not allow any applicant whose name appears on the U.S. Department of the Treasury's Office of Foreign Asset Controls (OFAC) Specially Designated Nationals (SDN) List or on OFAC's Consolidated List to enroll in a CSFI-sponsored course.
